SECURING A SETTLEMENT

The recent tour of Unit Representative Briefings demonstrated the strength of support for the Union's Four Pillars of Security. The Union's campaign has exposed the company's direction of travel since privatisation and their damaging proposals which threaten members' future employment, standard of living and retirement security.

Aimed at addressing the key challenges Royal Mail faces from unfair competition and automation, the Four Pillars of Security provide the basis for a lasting settlement with Royal Mail that will protect jobs, pay and pensions and ultimately determine the type of job and the sort of company you'll be working for in the years ahead.

Following the positive response to the CWU's Four Pillars petition and the strong show of support from our local Union Representatives right across the UK, the CWU will continue to put maximum pressure on the company to seriously re-engage with the Union, deal properly with all four issues (not just pensions) and work with us to secure a new agreement in line with our mutual interest culture that delivers future growth and success for the company, its customers and employees.

Members should understand that we are now at a serious stage in the talks and unless there is a substantial breakthrough prior to the Postal Executive meeting on 15th August, the Postal Executive will have no option or hesitation in carrying out the terms of Emergency Motion E5 and setting a timetable for an industrial action membership ballot.
